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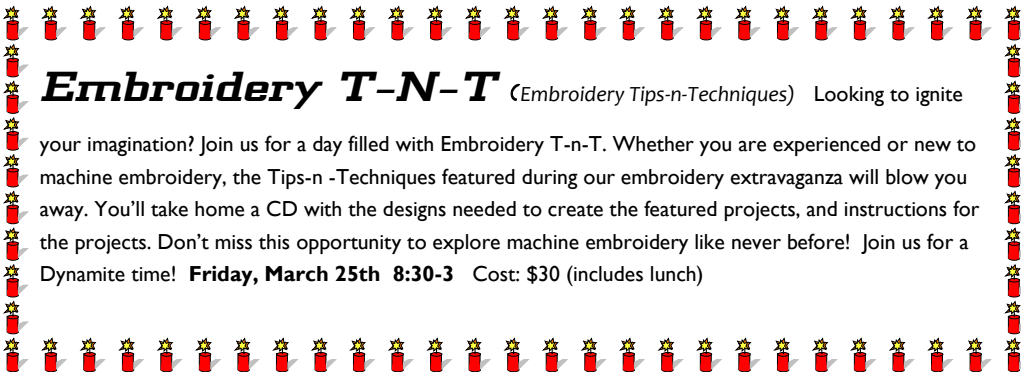

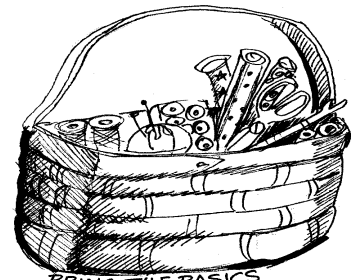

Create a lovely embroidery quilt by manipulating the embroidery designs of the *Floral Visions* Collection by OESD using the Bernina Embroidery Software. The Floral Visions Quilt has eight blocks plus a center medallion. The embroidery is the centerpiece of each block that makes up the quilt. Have fun using the creative tools in the software to design the quilt. Classes will meet periodically through April. Homework will be required to complete the quilt project. Teacher: Terri Sapp

Floral Visions Overview and Beginning Instructions (F.V. Overview) – In this first class of the series we will design your quilt using the Quilter program in your BERNINA Embroidery Software. *An overview of the entire series of classes will be given.* Computer loaded with V6 software required. Basic Hand Quilting—start to finish

Learn to quilt the way your grandmother did it, with her hands, needle and thread. However, we will use some of the new tools that make our craft a little easier, but still do all of the stitching by hand. You will learn how to make templates, piece, baste and quilt your project. This project will have both straight and curved seams. In the two part class, week one will cover the piecing and in week two, we will learn to baste and quilt by hand.

Blooming Nine Patch Class This beautiful quilt looks complicated but is actually easy to make; it's all in the fabrics you choose. Each block appears to blend into the next. This quilt works great with floral fabrics but also looks good with batiks. The first class will be choosing fabrics, bring fabrics you would like to use. Quilt size is 72" x 82", or you can make a queen or king size. Jewel Box Jewel Box is an all time favorite quilt pattern, made up of 4 patches and pieced blocks giving the impression of jewels. Lemoyne Star Stack 'N Whack Stack 'N Whack is a method of cutting that makes every block in the quilt look like it came from a different piece of fabric. It is so much fun to see how each one of your stars turns out; you can't wait until they are all sewn! Join the class as everyone ooh's & aah's over each others' blocks. This class is for all sewing levels. *Saturday, February 5 @ 10-4 Cost: \$60 Teacher: Debbie Bailey*

Make Your First Quilt – It Will Be Fabulous This quilt uses two sets of blocks. The first, using a stripe fabric creates a quick and dramatic block that alternates with the star blocks. But don't be afraid of those stars; you will make perfect points every time. Instruction will be aimed at the beginning quilter and detailed instruction will cover all the points of creating well pieced blocks that result in beautiful quilts. After completing this class you will have the skills you need to be a confident quilter. Total Eclipse Another great Judy Neimeyer pattern Foundation paper piecing, curved piecing, and traditional piecing skills are required to complete this quilt. 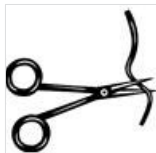

Beginner Machine Quilting

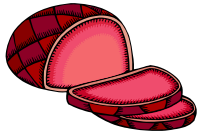

- 1/2 TO 3/4 CUP BROWN SUGAR
- 1 -2 TEASPOONS STONE GROUND MUSTARD
- 2-3 PKGS SISTER SCHUBERT'S YEAST ROLLS
- 3/4-1 LB. PROSCIUTTO HAM
- 3/4-1 LB. SWISS CHEESE

WHILE FROZEN, SLICE ROLLS THRU CENTER OF EACH PACKAGE OF ROLLS. CREAM BUTTER, BROWN SUGAR & MUSTARD. SPREAD THIS MIXTURE ON BOTH CUT SIDES OF EACH PACKAGE OF ROLLS. LAYER HAM & CHEESE ON BOTTOM LAYER OF ROLLS, REPLACE THE TOPS. COVER WITH FOIL.

REFRIGERATE UNTIL READY TO BAKE. PREHEAT OVEN 350
BAKE 20-30 MINUTES WITH FOIL LEFT ON. CUT APART & SERVE WARM.

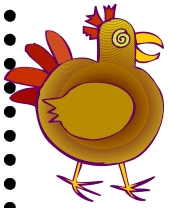

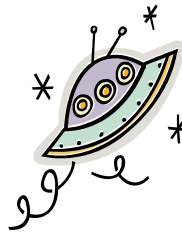
